1. Applications are invited from ITI qualified Indian citizen (both male / female) in the various designated trades for enrolment into apprenticeship training at Naval Ship Repair Yard, Karwar and Naval Aircraft Yard (Goa), Dabolim, Goa under Apprentices Act, 1961 read in conjunction with Apprenticeship Rules, 1992. A total of 150 vacancies for Naval Ship Repair Yard, Karwar and 23 vacancies for Naval Aircraft Yard (Goa), Dabolim, Goa as per distribution shown below are to be filled up:-
(a) Vacancies at Naval Ship Repair Yard, Karwar. Training for the candidates opting for these vacancies will be undertaken at Naval Ship Repair Yard, Karwar.

2. Eligibility Conditions.-

(a) Educational Qualification: Candidates who have scored above 50% marks in

Matriculation or Equivalent and above 65% marks in the relevant ITI trade recognized by National / State Council for Vocational Training (NCVT/ SCVT).

(b) Age: Candidates should have completed 14 years and below 21 years of age as on 01 Apr 2022 i.e. born between 01 Apr 2001 and 31 Mar 2008 (both dates inclusive). The upper age limit of 21 years is relaxable by five (05) years in the case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes (SC) / Scheduled Tribes (ST). The upper age limit may be further relaxed by two (02) years by Naval Headquarters at their discretion in respect of candidates who merit special consideration.

(c) Physical Standards: Height 150 Cms, Weight not less than 45 Kgs, Chest expansion not less than 5 Cms, Eye 6/6 to 6/9 (6/9 corrected with glasses), Ears clear of wax, External & Internal organs to be normal in accordance with The Apprentices Act, 1961.

(d) Previous Training: Candidates who have already undergone or undergoing apprenticeship training under Apprentices Act, 1961 in any other Govt. / Public Sector/ Private Industrial organization are not eligible to apply.

3. Reservation: Reservation of seats would be as per existing Govt. rules and regulations and provisions contained in Apprentices Act, 1961 as applicable and if vacancies cannot be filled, then vacancies so lying unfilled may be filled by other persons not belonging to concerned category.

4. Stipend: Monthly Stipend as per prescribed rates will be paid as per extant government rules and regulations. (Presently, Rs 7700/- per month for one year ITI certificate holder and Rs 8050/- per month for two year ITI certificate holder).

5. How to Apply: Interested eligible candidates are required to register online on www.apprenticeshipindia.gov.in. On completion of online registration, candidates are required to forward the "Apprentice Profile" along with the under mentioned documents by speed / registered post to "The Officer-in-Charge, Dockyard Apprentice School, Naval Ship Repair Yard, Naval Base, Karwar, Karnataka -581 308" within 30 days from the date of publication of this advertisement in Employment News.

(b) Attested copy of ITI Semester-wise Mark sheet and All Semester Mark Sheet

(c) Attested copy of Category Certificate (for EWS/OBC/SC/ST candidates only).

(d) Attested copy of Disability Certificate (for PwDs candidates only).

(e) Certificate from competent authority, if son / daughter of armed forces personnel/Naval Defence Civilian employee.

(f) Certificate of undertaking stating the choice of establishment for undergoing apprenticeship training i.e. Naval Ship Repair Yard, Karwar or Naval Aircraft Yard (Goa), Dabolim, Goa need to be clearly specified. Proforma of the certificate is as follows:-

6. Selection Procedure: Preliminary selection will be made on the basis of marks obtained in Matric and ITI examination. Candidates in the Preliminary Merit list will be called for written test and interview. A call letter for written examination will be issued to all eligible candidates on their registered email ID. Test / Interview is likely to be held in Jan / Feb 2022. Written examination would be objective type based on Mathematics, General Science and General Knowledge. A merit list shall be prepared on the basis of written examination. Candidates in the order of merit would be called for document verification / interview in various trades and applicable reservation categories. Candidates cleared in document verification/ interview will have to undergo medical examination. Joining Letter will be issued to the selected candidates on their registered email ID. Two separate merit lists will be drawn for two establishments i.e. one for Naval Ship Repair Yard, Karwar and one for Naval Aircraft Yard (Goa).

7. Travel Expenses: No travel expenses are admissible for candidates called for written examination. Only those candidates called for document verification /interview will be paid second class train fare from home /journey station to Karwar on production of original railway / bus ticket.

8. Boarding/Lodging: No accommodation will be provided to candidates by NSRY(Karwar) during entire selection process. Candidates called for written examination/ interview are to arrange their own boarding and lodging. Candidates qualifying written test are to sufficiently be prepared to accommodate themselves at their own arrangements for 3-4 days in case of spillover of interview and medical examination.

9. Commencement of Training/Apprenticeship Contract: Finally, selected candidates shall be offered apprenticeship contract as per the Apprentices Act, 1961 and they are to join Naval Ship Repair Yard, Karwar/Naval Aircraft Yard (Goa), Dabolim, Goa on the mentioned date (likely to be on 01 Apr 2022).

10. Hostel Facility:

(a) At Naval Ship Repair Yard, Karwar: Limited accommodation (for boys only) is available in the hostel on first come first serve basis for outstation candidates selected to undergo training at NSRY(Karwar).

(b) At Naval Aircraft Yard (Goa), Dabolim, Goa: No hostel facility would be available for candidates selected to undergo training at Naval Aircraft Yard (Goa).

11. Rejection: Application received after due date, overage, irrelevant ITI trade and incomplete application will be rejected and no further correspondence in this regard will be entertained.

12. No Obligation: In accordance with Apprentices Act,1961, it shall not be obligatory for Naval Ship Repair Yard, Karwar/ Naval Aircraft Yard (Goa) or any other Govt. agency to provide employment on completion of apprenticeship training.
