Subject: Attendance requirement for trainees' eligibility for taking up AITT 2021 scheduled in Dec 2021 -Jan 2022 – reg

Reference: Consultation on All India Trade Tests for Craftsmen held on 08 Nov. 2021 with State Directorate under the chairpersonship of DG(T).

Sir,

Reference is drawn to the issues discussed in the consultations on All India Trade Tests for Craftsmen held on 08 Nov. 2021 as mentioned above. During the consultations, most of the states proposed lower minimum attendance requirements for the trainees for their eligibility to appear in the examinations in view of COVID pandemic.

2. In view of the above, the competent authority has decided to consider 65% marks as minimum attendance eligibility for the trainees to appear in the examinations instead of 80%. The provision of granting 5% additional attendance relief to trainees lies with the discretion of State Directorates.
